## Still Time to Support the Dunwoody Police K9 Initiative



At our January Board meeting, we officially approved a donation of at least \$5,000 from the Dunwoody Rotary Charitable Fund to the Dunwoody Police Foundation in support of the launch of the K-9 unit for the Dunwoody Police Department. This donation will help expedite the launch of this important crime-fighting capability for the Dunwoody Police Department. Funding will help acquire and train two K-9s and prepare of two officers who will be trained as K-9 handlers.

At our meeting two weeks ago, several Dunwoody Rotarians pledged additional funds - and to date we have collected almost another \$5,000 in individual contributions.
