Legislative Update Street Grace Updates Human Trafficking Legislation

Street Grace recently updated the progress of human trafficking legislation in the Georgia legislature:

- SB 435 PASSED IN THE SENATE Moves to the House ... Vacatur and Expungement for Human Trafficking Survivors: Human Trafficking Survivors must have access to the courts to clean their records for true recovery and justice, led by our Survivor Advisory Board.
- HB 823 PASSED IN THE HOUSE Moves to the Senate ... Revoke CDL for Commercial Drivers who Engage in Trafficking: Those who engage in human trafficking must never be allowed to have a Commercial Driver's License.
- HB 272 ASSIGNED TO HOUSE REGULATED INDUSTRIES COMMITTEE ... Human Trafficking Education for Cosmetologists: Cosmetologists, hairdressers, and nail techs need to be trained to identify and safely respond to suspected human trafficking.

The Rotary Club of Dunwoody remains committed to ending human trafficking, and creating awareness of related issues.
