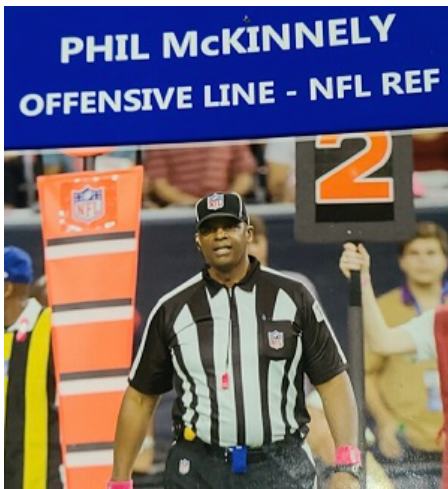

- GET's first production was in 1993 and is the resident professional theatre at the Roswell Cultural Arts Center.
- GET has produced 21 regular seasons of plays and musicals with 141 productions on the main stage at the Roswell Cultural Arts Center and on tour to elementary and middle schools throughout Georgia.
- In 2007, GET was awarded two CABY Awards: one for Outstanding Organization, and one for Excellence in Arts Education.
- GET has been nominated for numerous Suzi Bass Awards for artistic excellence in theatre and received awards from Atlanta Magazine for Best Theatre Company (Readers' Choice) in 2008 and Best Suburban Drama in 2011.
- GET offers a variety of educational opportunities through adult classes, youth classes, and summer camps.
- GET invests in students' arts education by offering touring Theatre for Young Audiences performances for elementary, middle, and high school students, by offering in-class workshops such as Literacy Through Drama for elementary students, and by developing Living Study Guide workshops for high school language arts classes.
- In the 2017-2018 season, GET reached over 30,000 students and teachers with curriculum-based, high-quality educational theatre through 20 performances in Fulton County Schools' Teaching

Museum North and field trips to the Roswell Cultural Arts Center.
