Happy Anniversary Roy and Franci!



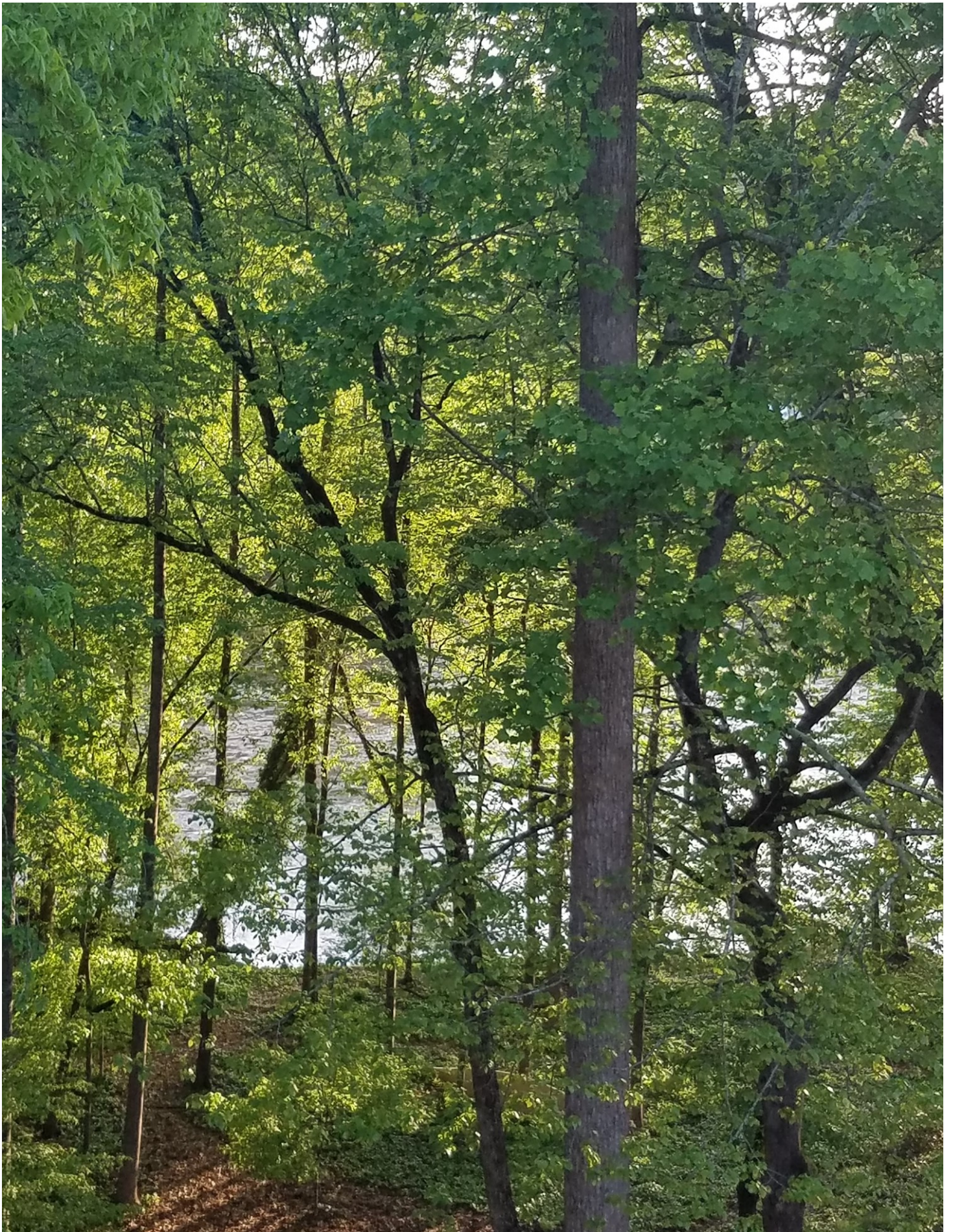
