**Amy Erskine** conducted the invocation and led the club in the Pledge of Allegiance and Four Way Test.



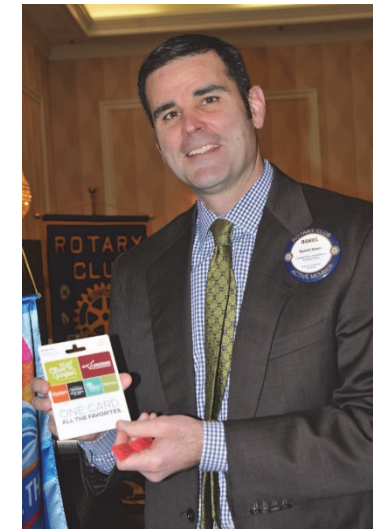
**Jack Le Grange** selected the winning raffle ticket.
