President-elect Keith Funderburk conducted the invocation and led the club in the Pledge of Allegiance and Four Way Test.



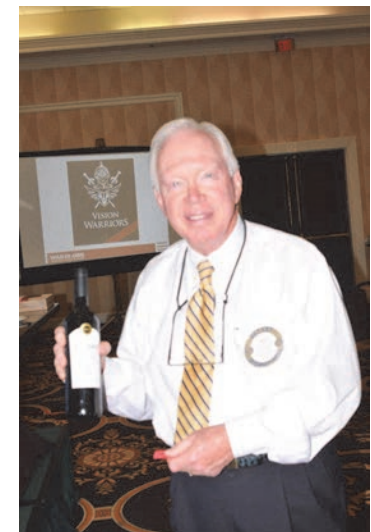
Kirk Driskell selected the winning raffle tickets.

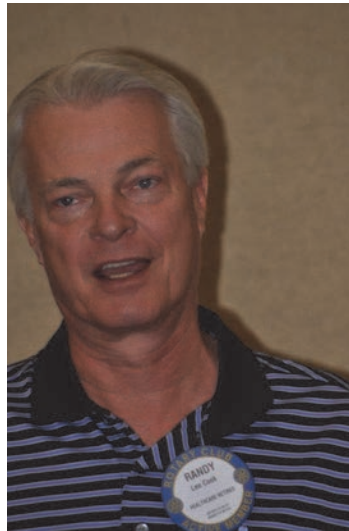
Buck Buchanan gave sunshine for a mission trip to Mexico and stated a nearby health clinic supported by a Marietta Metro Rotary International grant is doing well.
