William F. Bruton Jr. (Bill) was named Marietta's city manager in January 2000. He previously served as city manager of Hartsville, S.C., and Colonial Beach, Va. Bruton graduated from the University of North Carolina School of Law and holds a bachelor's degree in public administration and political science from Duke University, where he was president of the student body.

Bruton has won many professional and community awards, including the South Carolina Public Official Leadership Award in 1993 and 2000 and the Cobb YMCA Volunteer of the Year Award in 2012.

In 2010, Bruton was selected by the Carl Vinson Institute to travel to China where he taught city management principles at the

Past President Sally Platt selected the winning raffle tickets.



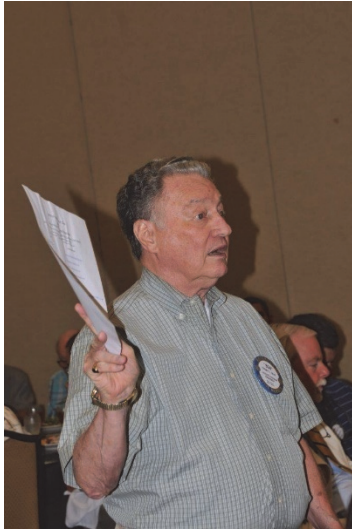
Chris Stokes, Mitch Simmons and Amy Erskine greeted members and guests.

The club donated to the CART fund in the memory of **Mitch Simmons'** mother.



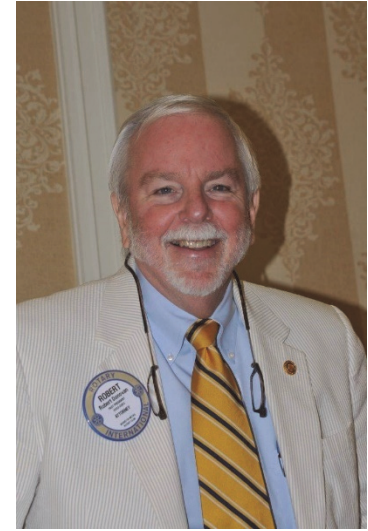
Chandler Vreeland gave sunshine for the visit to the club by **Marietta Police Chief Dan Flynn**.
