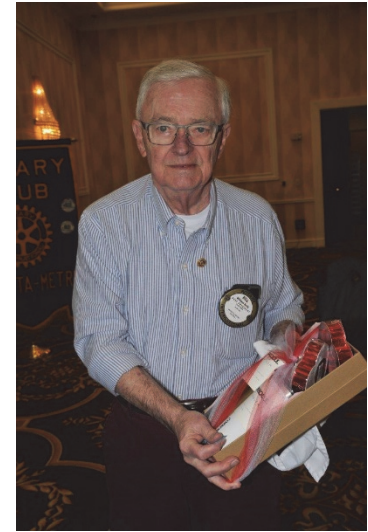
**February 10 Meeting
